

**SECOND RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE DESIGNATION OF AN AREA KNOWN
AS THE UPPER LAS VEGAS WASH AS AN URBAN NATIONAL PARK UNIT
MANAGED BY THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE**

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2009, the City Council adopted Resolution R-78-2009 for the purpose of urging the United States Congress, the U.S. Department of Interior, and the National Park Service to make a land management designation with respect to the Upper Las Vegas Wash that is appropriate for the protection of the resources, done in a timely manner to avoid further degradation of the area, and with appropriate funding to fully develop the area's scientific, educational and recreational potential; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to follow up Resolution R-78-2009 with a second resolution indicating the Council's support for actions that would meet the objectives of the concept map attached to this Resolution, which objectives are to designate land within City limits for a national park unit, expand the disposal boundary to include lands to be annexed to the City for future urban development, establish corridors for infrastructure, and convey land to the City for economic development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, by means of this Resolution, to urge the United States Congress, the U.S. Department of Interior, and the National Park Service to make a land management designation that:

1. Meets the objectives of the concept map attached to this Amended Resolution, as described above; and

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1 2. Is appropriate for the protection of the resources, done in a timely manner to avoid further
2 degradation of the area, with appropriate funding to fully develop the area's scientific, educational
3 and recreational potential.

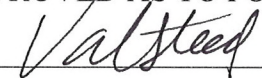
