PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On April 26, 2010, the Commission for the Las Vegas Centennial awarded \$300,000 to the City of Las Vegas for tenant improvements and hazardous material abatement at the Las Vegas Museum of Organized Crime and Law Enforcement located at 300 Stewart Avenue. Per the operating agreement for the Commission of the Las Vegas Centennial, any funding over \$100,000 must have council ratification.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that City Council ratify the Commission's funding allocation of \$300,000 for tenant improvements and hazardous material abatement at the museum.
