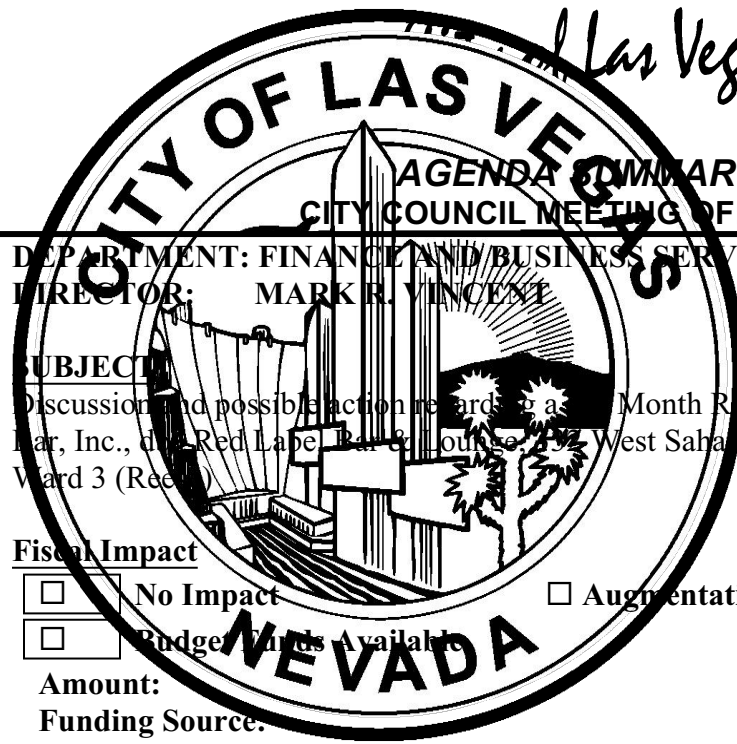

Motion made by GARY REESE to Approve subject to conditions and amending Conditions 2, 3 and 8 as follows:

2. Entertainment will be limited to Monday, Wednesday, Friday or Saturday nights from 6:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. for ages 21 and over for a six-month period.

3. Live bands to be limited to Monday, Wednesday, Friday or Saturday nights only, for a six-month period.

8. There shall be a three-month review.

Minutes:

CAROL MEYER, Business Services Supervisor, reported that when this matter was first considered in 12/2009, two conditions were imposed: no live entertainment at any time and a six-month review. Subsequently, NELY PETKOVA asked for a review of condition, and the

Council considered that request 4/2010, at which time eight additional conditions were imposed, which she read. This matter was placed on the agenda for a six-month review.

COUNCILMAN REESE stated that drastic changes to the conditions were made in April, and he indicated his preference for those conditions to remain for another three months. ATTORNEY LANCE HENDRON, representing NELY and BORIS PETKOVA, asked the Councilman if he would consider modifying Conditions 2 and 3. The Councilman indicated that after contact from one of the neighbors regarding an altercation between a couple, he would prefer to retain the conditions. Although the licensee is doing a good job, he fears things might change once a permanent license is issued, especially in dealing with such a difficult area.

COUNCILMAN ROSS continued with MS. MEYER that the applicant wants Conditions 2 and 3 modified. MR. PETKOVA, the general manager, indicated that all the businesses are undergoing economic hardships, and modifying Conditions 2 and 3 would enable them to compete with the nearby Stratosphere Tower by providing quality entertainment. He requested Condition 2 be modified to include Monday and Wednesday. COUNCILMAN REESE insisted on retaining the three-month review, and conceded to have live entertainment on Mondays and Wednesdays in the interior of the building only.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW clarified for COUNCILMAN REESE that live music can be provided every night once the permanent license is issued.
