PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On January 16, 2008 City Council approved the award of bid for the widening of Martin Luther King Boulevard. The award included upgrades to the traffic signals, median islands and other related work. This modification is to cover quantity adjustments, utility relocations and other work required to complete the project. Funding for this project is provided by the Regional Transportation Commission.

That City Council approve Modification No. 2 to Bid No. 07.1730.05-LED, Martin Luther King Boulevard Improvements, Alta Drive to Carey Avenue to Wells Cargo, Inc. in the amount of \$1,375,440.04 bringing the total contract amount to \$28,209,811.59 and increase the construction conflicts and contingency reserve by \$145,000 bringing the total amount to \$2,560,915.26. CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF: JULY 7, 2010

Minutes:

Upon the request of COUNCILMAN BARLOW, JORGE CERVANTES, Director of Public Works, explained that this is a settlement agreement with the contractor to pay for additional oil costs. The project was also extended in scope and for longer than anticipated. A clause in the contract allows them to obtain an adjustment.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN verified with MR. CERVANTES that funding for the project is provided by the Regional Transportation Commission.

MR. CERVANTES also explained that the entire project is expected to be completed the end of July or early August. COUNCILMAN BARLOW stated that it will be the most attractive Martin Luther King corridor in the nation and he looks forward to its reopening.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN verified that the project is from Utesco, approximately Discovery Drive, to Carey Avenue. Public Works is working on doing additional improvements down to Alta Drive to fill in the gap in conjunction with the Metro project. Part of Project Neon that the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) is working on will include Alta Drive down to Charleston Boulevard, over to I-15 and connect to Martin Luther King.
