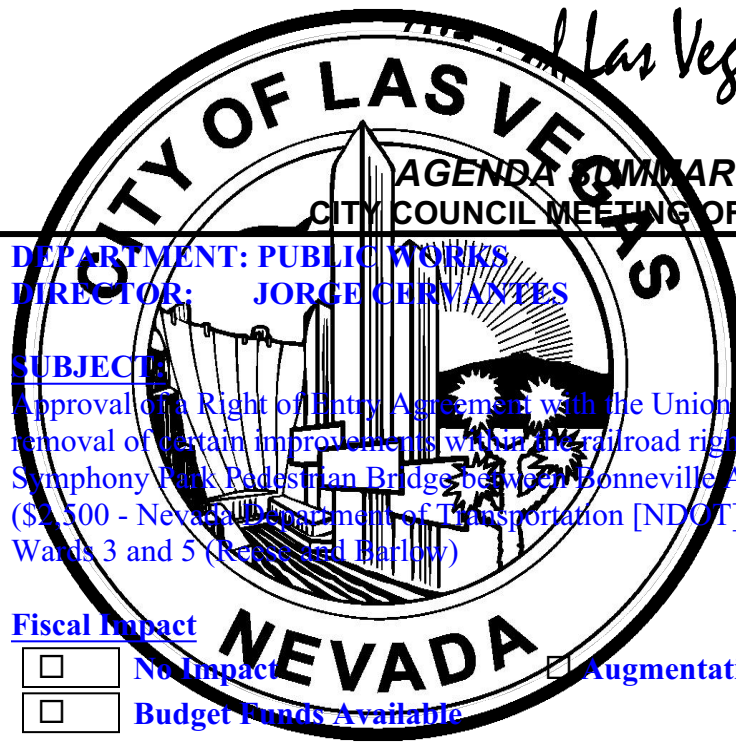

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Removal of certain Union Pacific Railroad aerial light fixtures, supporting poles and associated overhead wiring within its right of way has been authorized by the Union Pacific Railroad upon approval of the Right of Entry Agreement. Removal of these improvements is necessary to allow construction of a proposed pedestrian bridge connecting the proposed 500 South Main Street Parking Garage with Symphony Park. The expenditure is the administrative fee to be paid to the Union Pacific Railroad Company.
