Minutes:

COUNCILMAN REESE called forward CHRISTINA MARRONEZ, of SENATOR HARRY REID'S Office, NICOLAS RONCAGLIOLO, the Peruvian Consul General from San Francisco, California, for the recognition of Peruvian Independence Day.

COUNCILMAN REESE described the 2009 formed Peruvian Association, which engages in registering Peruvian businesses, as well as the Peruvian Cultural Association, whose main function is to share the Peruvian culture by performing Peruvian traditional dances. The Peruvian Cultural Association formed in 2005 to take part in the City's Centennial Parade and has remained active since then.

MR. RONCAGLIOLO accepted the City's Proclamation as well as the Proclamation from SENATOR REID'S Office in honor of the Peruvian Independence Day festivities.

Members of the Peruvian association carried the United States and Peruvian flags, and then MR. RONCAGLIOLO gave thanks to the Council for the recognition and for the opportunity to support the entire Las Vegas community and to strengthen relations between Las Vegas and Peru.
