

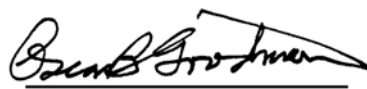

- THEREFORE;* We, the Mayor and Members of the Las Vegas City Council, do hereby take great pride in proclaiming July 21, 2010, as:

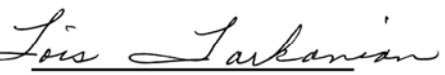

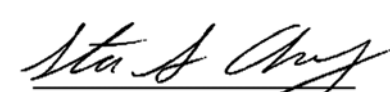
