PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This project provides for the installation of an Intelligence Traffic System (ITS) communication infrastructure which involves the installation and construction of Automatic Traffic Recovery (ATR) stations, loop detectors and fiber optic communications including conversion of existing traffic signal controllers to digital technology and replacement of existing CCTV cameras. Funding for this project is provided by the Regional Transportation Commission.

Minutes:

On behalf of some of her concerned constituents, COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN questioned the purpose of this project, its delay, and the final dollar amount. JORGE CERVANTES, Director of Public Works, replied that the scope of the project is to install fiber optic cables to interconnect traffic signals and replace existing cameras to monitor traffic for better flow. The areas include Rainbow Boulevard, from Charleston Boulevard to Sahara Avenue; Charleston Boulevard, from Desert Foothills Drive to Montclair Street; and Montclair Street, From Charleston Boulevard to Del Rey Avenue. All funding will be provided by the Regional Transportation Commission.
