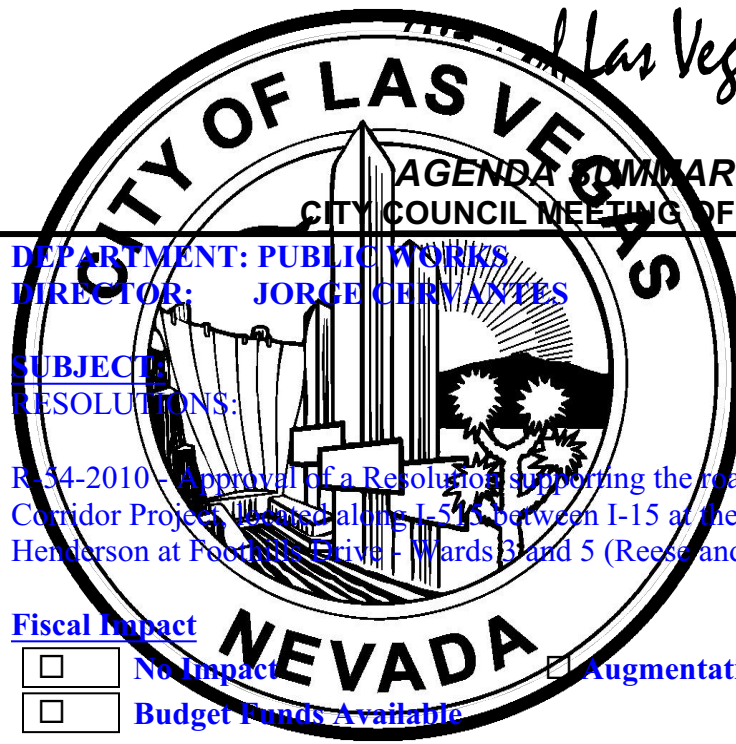

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This Resolution consents and supports the efforts of the Nevada Department of Transportation to develop and construct the I-515 Corridor Project, which includes the following roadway improvements: I-515 Freeway capacity improvements (widening), reconstruction of a portion of the downtown viaduct and the relocation of several downtown city facilities, new interchanges including City Parkway and Pecos Road, local street improvements including the Bonanza Road Grade Separation at Las Vegas Boulevard; reconfiguration of the Las Vegas Boulevard, Casino Center Boulevard and 4th Street interchanges to provide a Split Diamond Interchange; Stewart Avenue realignment to Pecos Road; along with various and operational improvements. Construction of frontage roads to improve the flow of traffic between Las Vegas Boulevard, Casino Center Boulevard and 4th Street interchanges, construction of ramps to provide direct access from 4th Street/Las Vegas Boulevard to I-15, reconfiguration of Southbound I-515 to provide express lanes for through traffic and local lanes serving downtown interchanges, reconstruction and expansion of the pedestrian and bicycle path along I-515.
