Dear Ms. Clerk:

Kindly allow this letter to introduce the undersigned as an attorney with the law firm representing the property owner, Mr. Michael E. Pavich.

Mr. Pavich received a letter, dated July 8, 2010, metered on July 12, 2010. Mr. Pavich works at the test site and did not receive the letter until sometime later. Although my associate, George Graziadei, and I appeared with Mr. Pavich before the City Council at a prior meeting, we did not receive a copy of the Notice.

The purpose of this letter is to respectfully request an abeyance of Agenda Item 64, to the meeting of August 18, 2010 or the next available meeting thereafter. The reasons for this request are, as follows:

1. As stated, Mr. Pavich did not receive timely notice and, therefore, has been unable to arrange his schedule to be present. He will be working at the test site on the date and time of the meeting of July 21, 2010.
2. I am unable to attend the meeting of July 21, 2010, at 1:00 p.m. In addition to the council meeting at issue, I have a deposition in a civil case at the same time; I am scheduled to give testimony in a Temporary Protective Order Hearing in Family Court at 1:30 p.m., and; I must represent a client at a criminal proceeding in Las Vegas Municipal Court at 1:45 p.m. I simply will be unable to meet all of those obligations. At the same time, my associate, Mr. Graziadei, has been of ill-health and is unable to

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appear in my stead.

3. This firm received no independent notice of the Hearing or Agenda Item and, therefore, I was unable to anticipate the appearance and attempt to rearrange my schedule.

For the foregoing reasons, I respectfully request that Agenda Item 64 at the City Council Meeting of July 21, 2010, be held in abeyance until August 18, 2010 or until the next available meeting thereafter.
