Minutes:

CITY ATTORNEY BRAD JERBIC advised MAYOR GOODMAN that the section of Nevada Law requires that a portion of a meeting must be devoted to Citizen Participation and it must retain a quorum. He suggested using the three-minute timer for each of the speakers and if anyone wants to speak after that, the Mayor can adjourn the meeting and listen to them.

DOROTHY BARNES, Las Vegas resident, once again stated that her rights are being violated and wants to her name removed from the programs. She is being victimized.

ROSS GALLO asked why, when and what will happen to his property because he has been in negotiations for over seven years. He has tried to speak to someone in the Building and Housing Department with no success. He lost access to his property during Helldorado, had to rent a motel room, and was unable to park his car. MAYOR GOODMAN referred MR. GALLO to City staff to provide him guidance.

HECTOR CAMACHO verified that Item 63 was denied and submitted a letter and photographs concerning Item 61 and stated that the property was cleaned. He is willing to comply and asked to meet with MAYOR GOODMAN and COUNCILMAN REESE. He will send tapes with an explanation and asked the Mayor to view the tapes.
