De CALL THOMAS explained his family owns a welding business and had completed work for a home owned under the Housing Authority. They bought the property into ADA compliance and has since found out that the performance bond was not valid; he felt that the City did not exercise due diligence in ensuring the bond was not a fraudulent one. COUNCILMAN REESE recalled speaking with MR. THOMAS' father regarding this matter, and MR. THOMAS confirmed that a contract, along with other documentation, was presented. His family simply wants to be compensated for the work they completed. The Councilman understood MR. THOMAS' quest and directed staff to investigate, as he was not sure if it was the City's responsibility to validate performance bonds. He noted that the name used was the City of Las Vegas Housing Authority, when in fact, the Housing Authority is a separate entity and the only relation to the City is that MAYOR GOODMAN appoints members to the Housing Authority.

CALVIN FUTRELL introduced youths, JACKIE, JOSE, JAZZMINE, HADIE and JESSIE. These are some of the youth that volunteer their time in the community. MR. FUTRELL spoke on his commitment in working with the youth and was disappointed that some of them did not have an opportunity to receive back-to-school supplies. COUNCILMAN REESE advised MR. FUTRELL to contact his office, so the youth can receive some supplies. MR. FUTRELL recognized the Council has a busy schedule, but beckoned the members to be available for the youth, as they are the future.

MAYOR GOODMAN thanked MR. FUTRELL for his efforts in working with the youth.
