- Therefore;* We, the Mayor and Members of the Las Vegas City Council, proudly proclaim September, 2010:

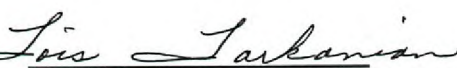

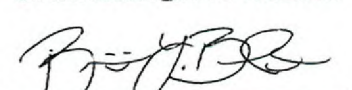
