Minutes:

ANTHONY HODGES, Las Vegas resident, referred to a letter from the 1960's that included signatures from various prominent people including Robert F. Kennedy. He also mentioned that he has traveled all over the country, and he believes that it will come back to the top.

TODD FARLOW, Las Vegas resident, stressed that the IT systems for law enforcement, attorneys and courts need to be interconnected.

DANIEL FERLIN, Ward 6 resident, alleged that he was not allowed to speak on Items 29 and 30 of this agenda. MAYOR GOODMAN asserted that no one came forward asking to speak on those matters.

MR. FERLIN expressed concern about the process for the approval of Molly's. He argued that he saw the re-zoning sign for the first time a week ago and that many people were not made aware of this meeting because of the geography of the area and the 1,000 radius used to send notices, noting that the majority of the residents reside to the east of Molly's. He went over the list of properties that were notified, many of which are owned by the federal government, are businesses or banks, or vacant properties.
