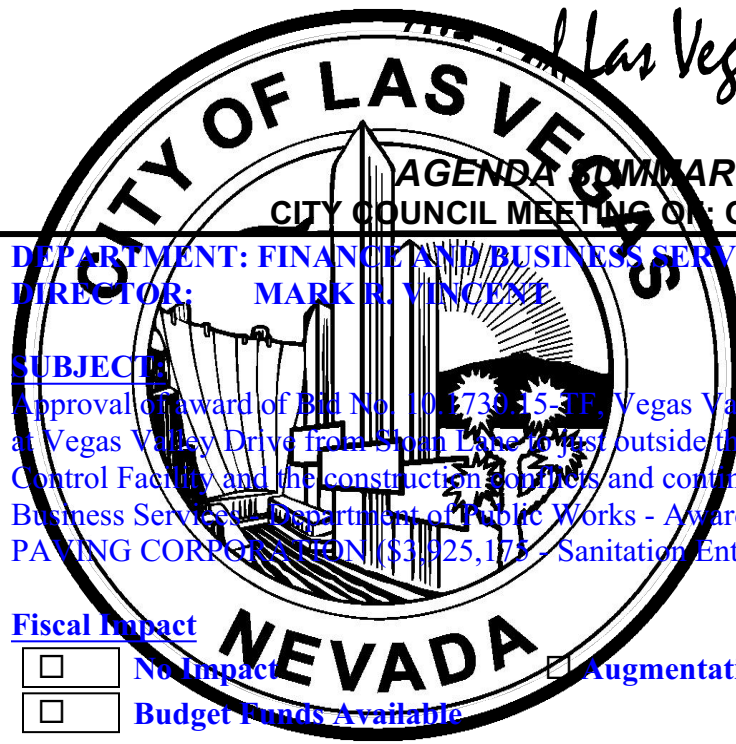

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This project consists of the rehabilitation of approximately 1500 linear feet each of 57 inch and 66 inch sanitary sewer using trenchless technology and cured-in-place pipe via an upstream or downstream inversion. The project also includes the inspection and point repair of approximately 1500 linear feet of reinforced concrete pipe and a downstream junction structure as well as the design of a bypass pumping and piping system and other project related work.
