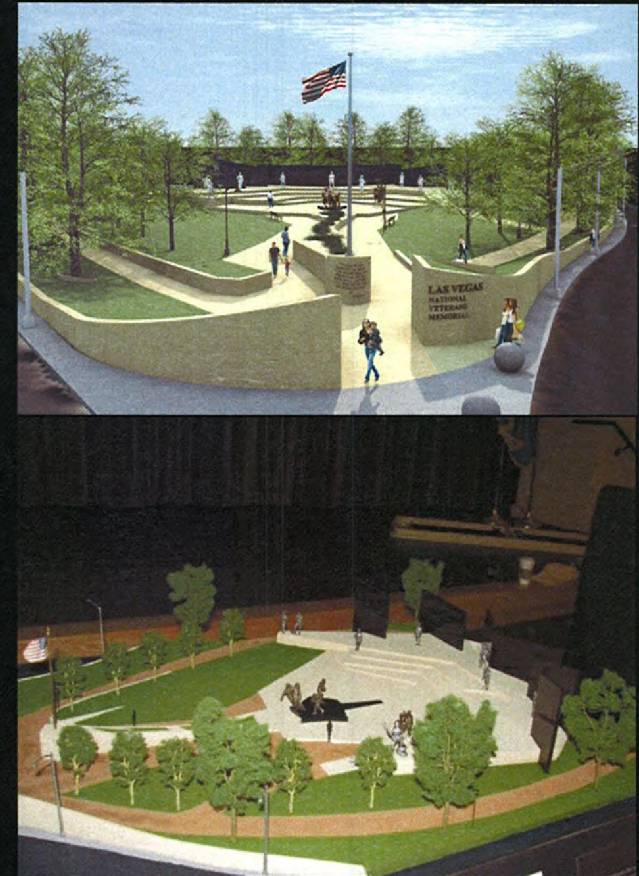

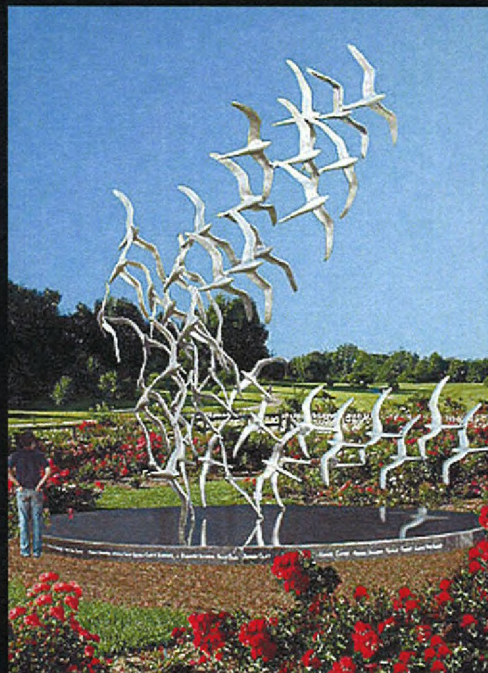

Longmont, Colorado*

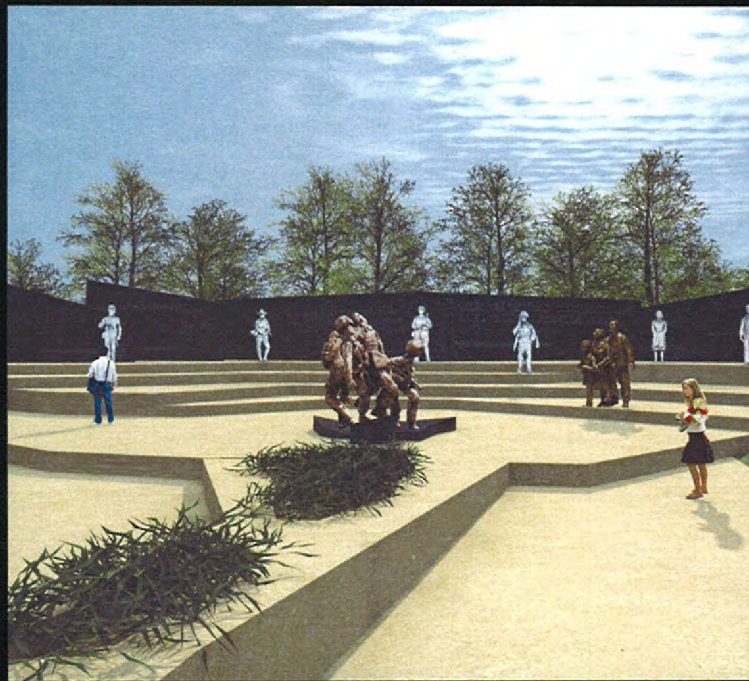

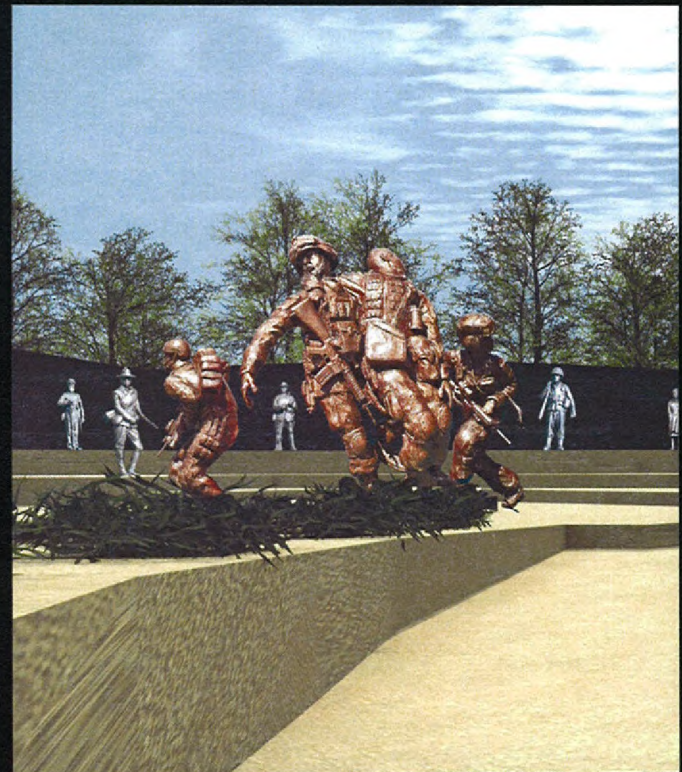

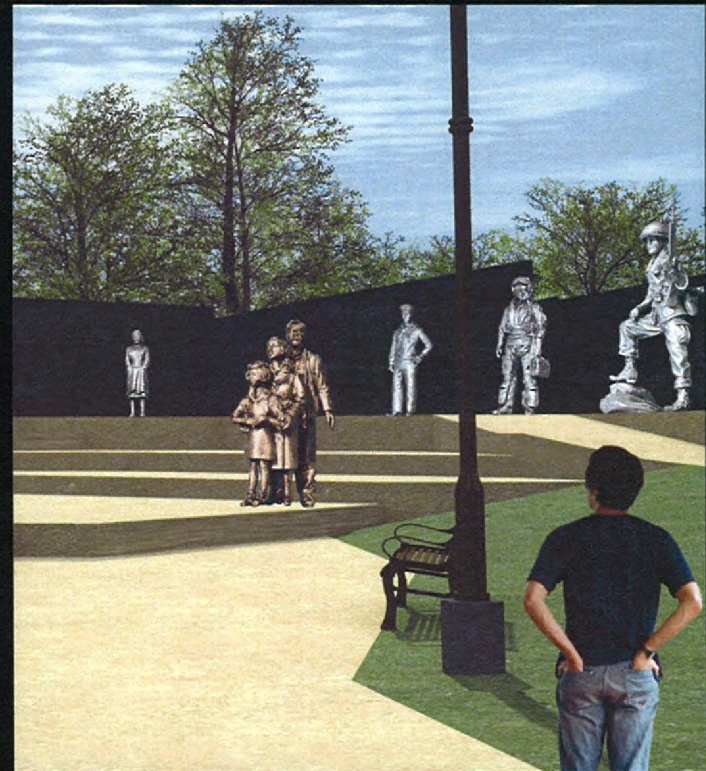


- Haunting sculptures representing American military involvement

*The American veterans' experience remains fundamentally unchanged from Bunker Hill to Fallujah*



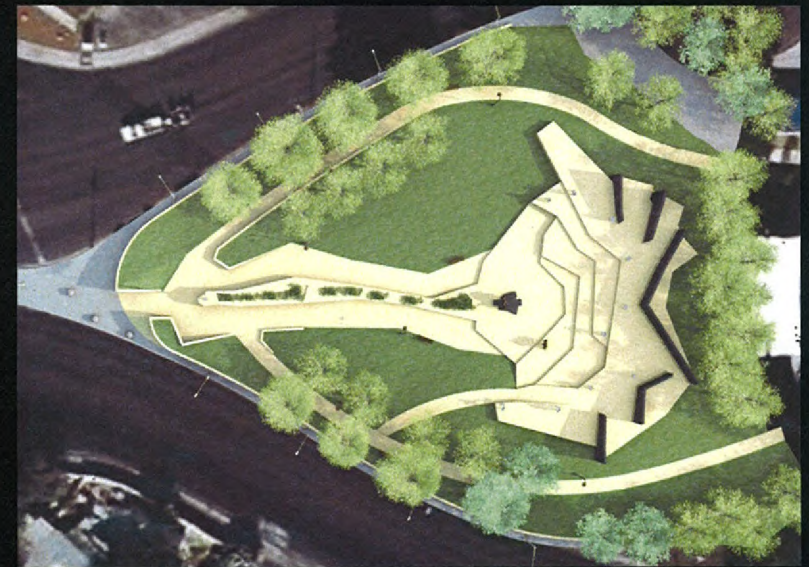
*Their dedication and sacrifice, shared by their loved ones, form the very pages upon which our country's history has, and will be written.*
