COUNCILMAN ROSS recognized soldiers who continue to sacrifice in keeping this country free and thanked them for their bravery.

In addition to the upcoming annual Veterans Day Parade, COUNCILMAN ROSS invited everyone to attend the American Heroes Challenge event, which will be held at the Clark County Shooting Park on November 6th and 7th. First responders and tactical teams from around the country compete, and the events are free to the public. Proceeds will go towards the local Veterans Memorial. Also, on November 11th and 12th, the Fremont Street Experience will be hosting a patriot party, with events that will highlight what the Veterans do and have done for us.

COUNCILMAN ROSS invited ESSENTIAL CARTER, Office of Cultural Affairs, to the podium to give details on the upcoming Veterans Day Parade, which will be held on November 11th at 10:00 a.m. She had the pleasure of working with DAILY STOJAK and MARK CHRISTENSEN on these upcoming events.

COUNCILMAN ROSS read the proclamation and then presented it to MS. CARTER.
