Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN invited JOE MARCELLA, Director of Information Technologies, ANTHONY WILLIS and RICHARD WELLS to the podium to recognize Geographic Information System (GIS) Day. The Mayor remarked that the City uses GIS every day to interpret and understand data, as well as reach out to citizens to inform them of projects in their part of the City. MAYOR GOODMAN thanked MR. MARCELLA and his staff and presented him with a proclamation.

MR. WILLIS stated that GIS staff members take this technology to schools and teach them about GIS. He thanked the Mayor and City Council for the recognition. MR. MARCELLA added that most City business is based on GIS applications.
