COUNCILMAN BARLOW thanked STAN WASHINGTON for the video. He announced that the grand opening of the Flamingo Drive Interchange will take place on Friday, January 7. MAYOR GOODMAN indicated he cannot attend as he and CITY MANAGER ELIZABETH FRETWELL will be meeting with GOVERNOR BRIAN SANDOVAL.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW announced that on Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. he will host Coffee with the Councilman at Starbucks at Rancho Drive and Bonanza Road. He invited the entire community to the Martin Luther King Parade on January 17 beginning at 10:00 a.m. On January 18, he and CITY MANAGER FRETWELL will be hosting the Ward 5 Town Hall meeting at the Doolittle Community Center starting at 5:30 p.m. He wished everyone a Happy New Year.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN indicated that Ward 1 Town Hall meeting will be held on Wednesday, January 12 at 5:30 p.m. at Charleston Heights Arts Center, 800 Brush Street. CITY MANAGER FRETWELL will lead the meeting covering achievements of the past year and goals for the coming year.

COUNCILMAN WOLFSON announced that last year eight of the 13 missing children featured during the City Council meeting were located. He was notified that the juvenile he was ready to present was located today.

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY announced that the first Ward 4 Business Network meeting will be held on January 13 at 6:00 p.m. at the Durango Hills YMCA. This is a network he started to allow Ward 4 business owners to meet with him. State legislators representing Ward 4 will attend and speak on the upcoming legislative session as it relates to businesses.

On behalf of the entire City Council, MAYOR GOODMAN invited the public to attend the City's Town Hall meetings. These meetings are a follow-up to last year's program "Call Your City Your Way", where the City Manager will discuss the City's finances, redevelopment and the progress the City is making regarding its priorities. Small group discussions will be held to get input. The public's attendance and participation is very crucial.
