RECOGNITION OF FIRE STATION 6 FOR SUSTAINABLE DESIGN

Minutes:

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN recognized Fire Station 6, which started as a public/public partnership between the College of Southern Nevada and the City of Las Vegas for the purpose of providing an integrated facility with seamless interaction between the two institutions. After the Station opened, the Clark County School District developed a Fire Science Magnet Program offered through Bonanza High School, which is located across the street.

Recently Station 6 was awarded the Best Small Project, under \$10 million, by Southwest Contractor Magazine and a Station Style Design Award for Notable Shared Facility project by Fire Chief Magazine. To help present these awards, the Councilwoman called forward MIKE MYERS, Chief of Las Vegas Fire and Rescue, JOSH BRUMMELS, Project Manager, and RYAN HEATER, Project Director, of McCarthy Building. Also, WALKER, Director of the McCarthy Building Nevada Division of Business Development and Councilman of Boulder City, and representatives of JMA Architecture Studios.

MR. BRUMMELS presented the award from Southwest Contractor Magazine to COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN. Southwest Contractor Magazine chose this project, after surveying the country, for working with multiple entities to complete the project and bringing it under budget and ahead of schedule.

CHIEF MYERS presented the award from Fire Chief Magazine for the unique design and gave thanks to McCarthy Building and JMA Architects for the wonderful building.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN remarked that people do not realize that there is nice architecture beyond the hotels and casinos.

MAYOR GOODMAN gave credit to COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN, who came up with the idea of this unique partnership. It is the only one of its kind in the world.
