On behalf of the entire Board of Trustees of the Nevada Law Foundation, I am pleased to inform you that your organization has been awarded \$105,000 for the 2011 grant cycle. Enclosed is a check for the first the first half of your grant award, \$52,500, the second installment will be sent on July 1.

Grants dispersed by the Nevada Law Foundation are funded by the Nevada Interest On Lawyers Trust Accounts (IOLTA) Program.
