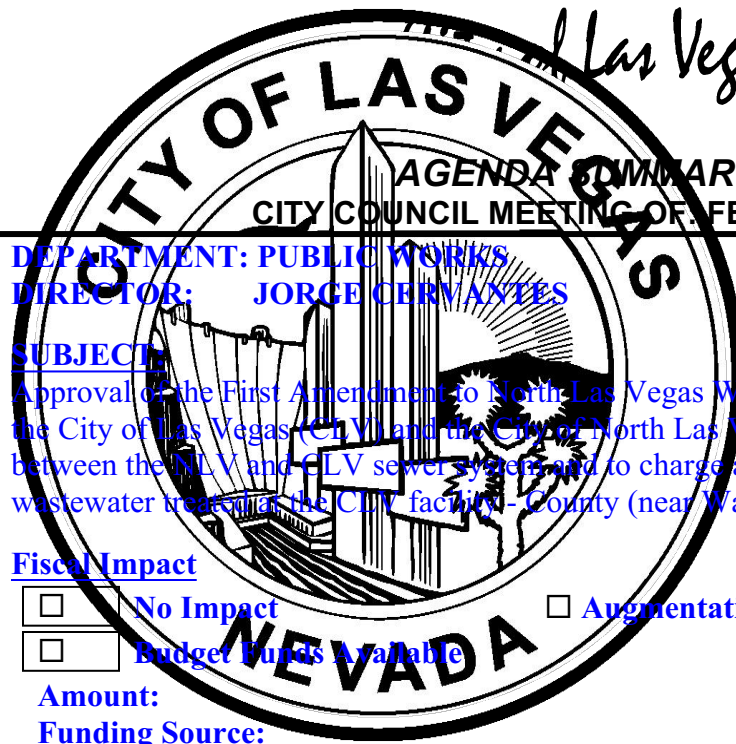

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The City of Las Vegas and North Las Vegas entered into an agreement in 1981 which was renewed on February 4, 2009. Under the contract, North Las Vegas was authorized to connect its wastewater collection system into the City of Las Vegas sewer collection system. The City of Las Vegas processed and treated all of the indirect wastewater flows and the direct wastewater flows discharged into the CLV wastewater collection system from NLV wastewater collection system. NLV is constructing a Wastewater Treatment Facility which will receive and treat the indirect wastewater flows generated by the sewer accounts located in NLV.
