PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Current zoning regulations that govern the computation of time within which certain acts must be performed exclude from consideration Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. This bill will add to that list any day that the City's principal administrative offices are officially closed to the public. The primary intent is to adjust to the fact that the City's principal offices are closed on Fridays.
