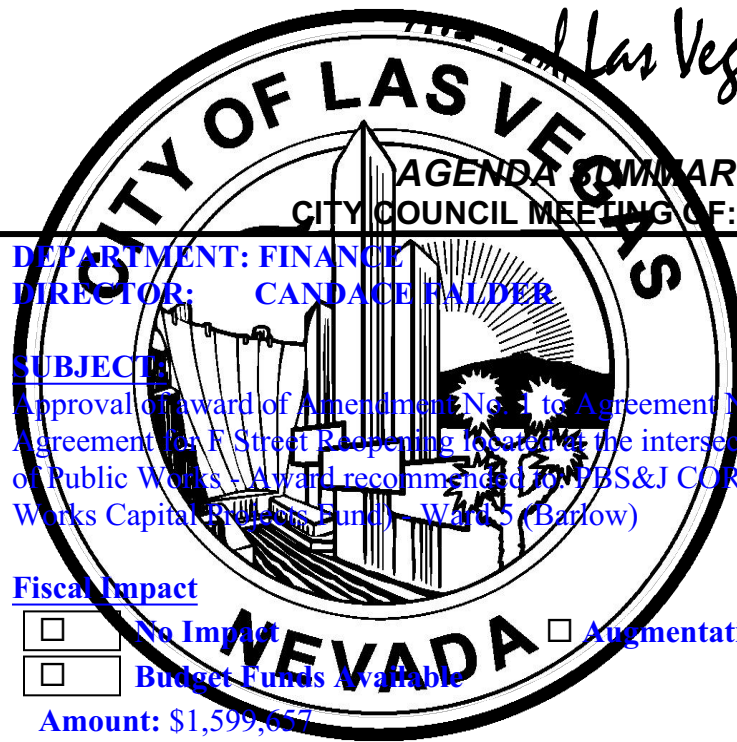

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On March 17, 2010 City Council approved award of Agreement No. 100168-LD for design services to develop specifications and plans for the bidding of a construction project to reopen "F" Street. The original agreement required a 30% design and this amendment takes the design to 100%. This item is exempt from the competitive bidding process pursuant to NRS 332.11.1(b), Professional Services. Funding is being provided by the Redevelopment Agency.

KATHERINE DUNCAN read and submitted her comments alleging that the Council has failed to assist her neighborhood with developing a neighborhood master plan and to openly apologize for the impact of the closure of F Street to the neighborhood. She urged the Council to develop a plan.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW disagreed with MS DUNCAN'S comments and pointed out that he has been working with members of the community to ensure the transparency of the entire process of reopening the bridge and the overall master plan of the community. The reason for so much of the ongoing construction is due to new development in the area.
