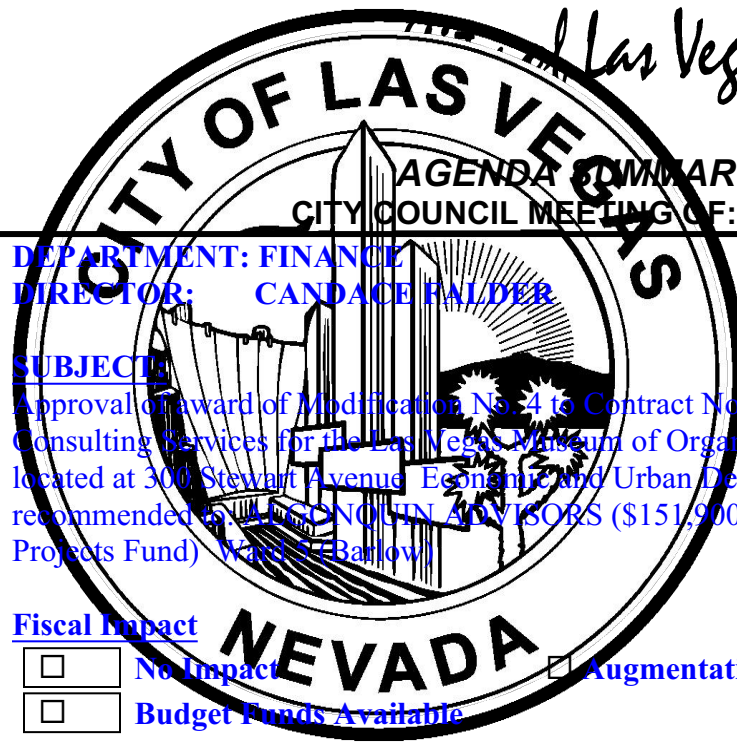

On February 2, 2009 Council approved the award of Contract No. 090112-PL in the amount of \$121,500 to provide management consulting services to oversee and coordinate the development of the Museum of Organized Crime and Law Enforcement.
