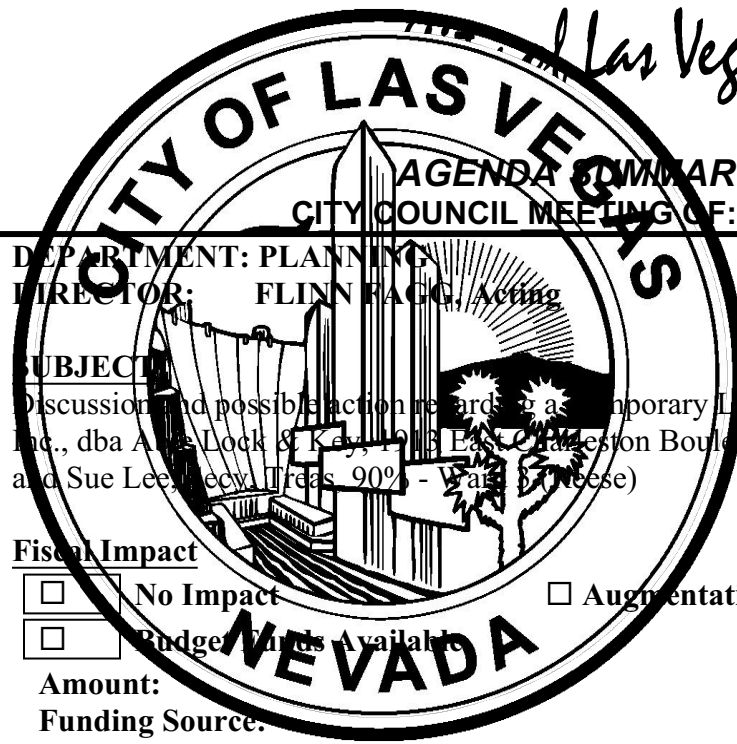

Minutes:

COUNCILMAN REESE recognized JIM DiFIORE, Manager of Business Services, for all his years of service to the City and his hard work. MAYOR GOODMAN and COUNCILMEMBERS WOLFSON, TARKANIAN, BARLOW and ROSS added that MR. DiFIORE has always handled every job and direction of the Council with great expertise and professionalism. They congratulated him on his retirement and wished him well. MR. DiFIORE appreciated the kind words and stated he intends to spend time with his grandchildren and open his own business in the future.

Sequentially, CAROL MEYER, Supervisor of Business Services, reported that SONIA OSBOURNE, who was present with SUE LEE and JINHUA ING, certified interpreter, withdrew without prejudice her application of 11/18/2009. In 5/2010, she re-applied with MS. LEE, MS. OSBOURNE'S sister, and a temporary license was issued 6/2010, with an extension granted in 9/2010, subject to several conditions, which MS. MEYER read. The background investigation was recently completed and it revealed a concern.

MAYOR GOODMAN confirmed with the applicants that they all understood everything being said.

MS. MEYER recommended a permanent license be granted, subject to Conditions 1-3 and amending 4 and 5, which she read and the applicants agreed to.
