I never heard back from you regarding your plan, as you had promised.

It is my understanding that you are going forward with your package liquor (SUP-40520) application at City Council.

I noticed that there were 0 protests listed in the documentation, that is not true however. Let this email serve effectively as 10 protests.

I find it only fair to advise you that we (Fremont East) have been in communication with our councilman, Ricki Barlow, as well as Mayor Goodman on this issue, and they will also be copied on this email.

Let me emphasize one more time exactly how we feel about this issue:

- We are AGAINST liquor sales of ANY kind, including "gift bags"
- We are against sales of SINGLE beer, malt liquor, or anything else deemed "malt beverage" regardless of alcohol content.
- We are okay with the sales of: 6 packs, 12 packs, and cases (24) of beer
- We are okay with proper sales of wine

These were things the we discussed face-to-face in our meeting at the El Cortez immediately after the Planning Commission voted 7-0 for the denial of your request.

I hope that I have clearly expressed how the business owners and property owners of the adjoining district feel, and you can empathize with our position.

I will be unable to make the meeting, as I will be out of town unfortunately.
