PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The condition of the property was a public hazard and an attractive nuisance. The Department of Building and Safety declared the property in violation and started legal notification. When no corrective action was taken nor an appeal filed, the Department of Building and Safety hired American Demolition to remove all trash and debris, and remove all high weeds and grass from all areas, and apply herbicide, secure all windows, doors, and openings, board patio slider, and remove non-permitted sheds. To date, there have been seven (7) inspections conducted at this location. The estimated value of the property based on Zillow.com is \$176,000.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council: Approve the report of expenses to include \$1,290 invoice for American Demolition in addition to other fees assessed for a total of \$3,857.50 and consider assessing a maximum of \$41,050 in daily civil penalties.
