PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

In order to receive federal and state funds for housing, homeless, and community development activities, the City of Las Vegas must submit an Action Plan to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) no later than May 15, 2011. The Draft Action Plan outlines activities that will be undertaken by the City of Las Vegas for the period of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. Funding sources include CDBG, ESG, HOME and HOPWA funds from HUD; and HOME funds from the State of Nevada.

Staff recommends that Council approve the submittal of the City of Las Vegas 2011-2012 Action Plan to HUD, including consideration of public comment as required by HUD.
