PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The committee consists of five members to represent the residential construction, commercial development and construction industries, a public officer of the City who manages the fiscal affairs of the City and a public officer of the Department of Building and Safety who oversees directly the operation of the Enterprise Fund. Appointments are recommended by the City Manager and approved by the City Council. Terms are for two years; no limit to the number of terms, with no City Residency requirement. Mr. Chachas was originally appointed in May of 2007 to represent the Residential Construction Industry and in 2009 his nomination for reappointment came from the Southern Nevada Home Builders Association. He is eligible and wishes to be reappointed.
