COUNCILMAN WOLFSON invited business owners located in Ward 4 to attend his next Ward 4 Business Network meeting to be held Thursday, May 12, 6:00 p.m. at the Durango Hills YMCA. COUNCILMAN WOLFSON indicated that he has been highlighting a missing child at each Council meeting for a year and since then over half of those missing children have been located. He thanked Nevada Child Seekers for giving him the opportunity to bring their mission to the community in this way. He introduced another missing juvenile.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN referred to trees being planted on Evergreen Street near Decatur Boulevard. At first, the residents did not want the trees but she is amazed how now they are asking that more trees be planted. Another date was scheduled for a second planting of the trees that will create a tree canopy in this neighborhood.

COUNCILMAN ROSS thanked the Council for joining him in celebrating Helldorado Days in downtown Las Vegas.
