**RECOGNITION OF THE PAVILION POOL FOR RECEIVING GREEN GLOBE CERTIFICATION**

Minutes:

COUNCILMAN WOLFSON recognized one of the City's most popular amenities that has recently been improved and is now part of the City's Sustainability Initiative. He was pleased to announce that a natatorium pool cover, has been built over the Pavilion Pool in Ward 2, allowing for year-round use. The City of Las Vegas has made sustainability one of its top priorities, and this pool enclosure was designed with that in mind. It has been given a Two Green Globe Certification by the Green Building Initiative, equivalent to the LEED Silver Certification. He invited JORGE CERVANTES, Director of Public Works, and TOM PERRIGO, Deputy Director of Administrative Services, to the podium to present them with a plaque recognizing the Pavilion Pool for its innovation.

MR. CERVANTES stated the enclosure allows for the pool to be used year-round with a retractable roof and sliding side glass doors. MR. PERRIGO added that the certification of the structure is the result of a policy the Council adopted as part of the Green Building Resolution to ensure City buildings are more energy efficient and environmentally friendly. That long-term strategy has led to the City being recognized as a world leader in Green Building. COUNCILMAN WOLFSON thanked MR. CERVANTES and MR. PERRIGO for leading these initiatives.
