PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The grant funding will allow the SCLP to provide preventative, informational legal seminars to Clark County residents, who are 60 years of age and older. The funding will also support efforts to design a brochure for the public, which describes the comprehensive continuation of services offered by the SCLP. Due to the increase in foreclosure issues and other consumer matters, a waiting list has been developed for clients to meet with a counselor to discuss relative needs. Through the presentation of free informational seminars, large numbers of seniors can be assisted in a relatively short period of time, thus maximizing the SCLP's limited resources. State Bar of Nevada grant monies will be utilized to purchase office supplies, upgrade technology, purchase equipment, refreshments and copies for informational hand-outs, which are necessary for the presentation of free informational legal seminars throughout the community.

Staff recommends approval of the State Bar of Nevada's Public Service and Law Related grant award and authorizes of the City Manager to execute any and all related agreements and documents following approval as to form by the City Attorney.
