LRIS PUBLIC SERVICE GRANT PROGRAM
AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is being entered into this 18th day of May, 2011 by and between the State Bar of Nevada (State Bar) and Senior Citizens Law Project (Organization) for community outreach and technology upgrade.

1. In consideration of the sum of \$30,700 which is being awarded to the Organization from the State Bar as part of the State Bar's LRIS Public Service Grant Program, the Organization agrees:
 - a) To use the above funds for the purpose of the public service project proposal submitted by the Organization to the State Bar.
 - b) To provide a final report to the State Bar of the above project's activities by February 1, 2012. The report shall include an accounting of the use of the money provided by the State Bar.
 - c) To provide copies of all work products generated by, through and as a result of the project, and that all such work product shall be available to the State Bar for its use and dissemination to other local bar groups, or as needed in the State Bar's discretion. Any work product so generated that is subject to copyright or trademark protection shall be required to include the name of the State Bar of Nevada.
 - d) That the project has an anticipated completion date of June 30, 2012. Monies remaining from the State Bar Grant at the completion of the project shall be returned to the State Bar. In unusual circumstances, should the timetable for completion of the project need to be extended, the Organization shall request an extension of time in writing prior to the original anticipated completion date. An accounting for monies spent up to the date of the request for extension shall be submitted with the request, along with an explanation as to why the extension is needed and a final completion date.
2. Originals of the final product will be available to the State Bar of Nevada.
3. Whether the product requires a copyright or not, credit shall be given to the State Bar for its involvement and support.
4. No Organization members shall receive payment from the grant except for out-of-pocket expenses.
