PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The City of Las Vegas entered into a Funding Agreement with the Nevada Division of State Lands (Question 1 Grant) on February 12, 2009 for the Las Vegas Wash Trail and Sandhill Owens Trailhead projects. This Amendment will revise state funding from \$730,000 to \$303,447 to align project budget with actual bid prices. This amendment will also extend the completion date to December 31, 2011 to allow for project close-out and reimbursements. This Agreement has been reviewed by the City Attorneys office and stamp verified accordingly.
