PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The condition of the property was a public hazard and an attractive nuisance. The Department of Building and Safety declared the property in violation and started legal notification. When no corrective action was taken nor an appeal, the Department of Building and Safety hired Blast Janitorial Services to board all open doors and windows, and remove all trash, debris, and discarded items. To date, there have been seven (7) inspections conducted at this location. The estimated value of the property based on Zillow.com is \$15,000.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council: Approve the report of expenses to include \$500 invoice for Blast Janitorial Services in addition to other fees assessed for a total of \$2,251 and consider assessing a maximum of \$46,550 in daily civil penalties.
