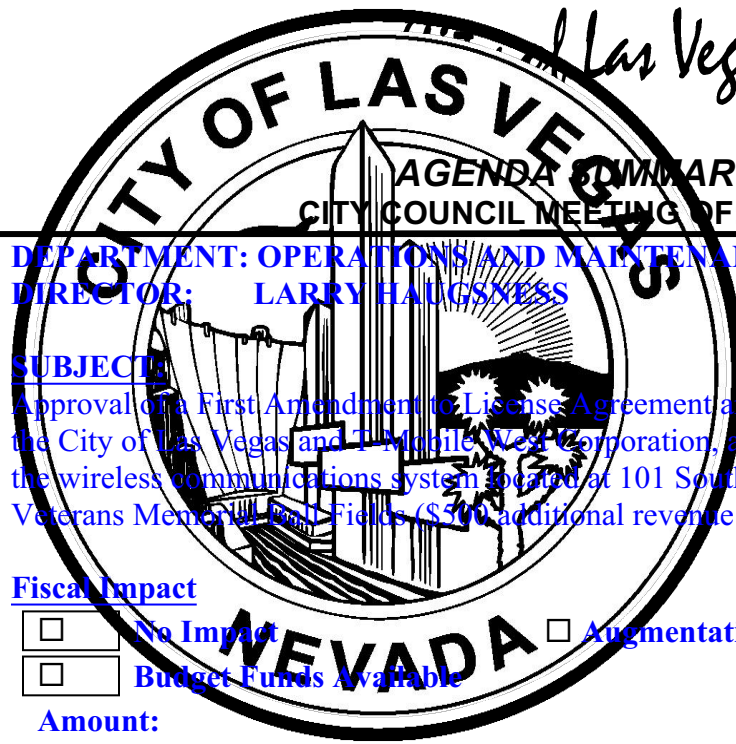

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The City and T-Mobile entered into a License Agreement for the installation of a wireless communications system on January 4, 2007. This Amendment will allow T-Mobile to sublet space within its Premises to Lightsquared Inc., pursuant to a separate sublease or license agreement between T-Mobile and Lightsquared. In consideration for the City's consent to sublease pursuant to this Amendment, T-Mobile shall pay to the City an additional \$500 per month. The City agrees to execute a Memorandum of Agreement which details the terms of the Agreement and may be recorded.
