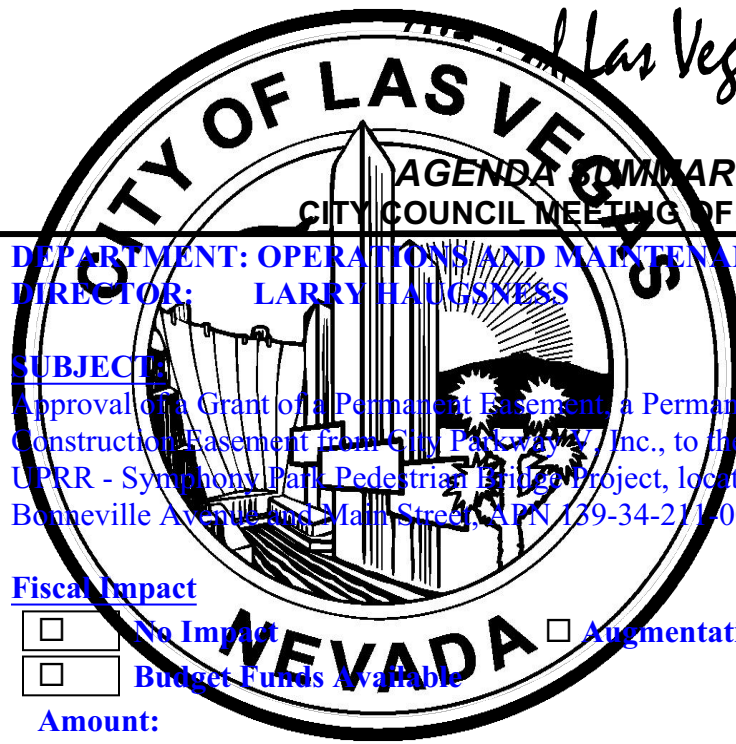

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

In the furtherance of the UPRR - Symphony Park Pedestrian Bridge Project, it shall be necessary to construct a pedestrian bridge over the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR). The bridge will provide pedestrian access from the 500 South Main Street Parking Garage to the Symphony Park development, in particular the Smith Center for Performing Arts. The western touchdown area for the pedestrian bridge will be in a parcel of land owned by City Parkway V, Inc. Thus, these easements will be necessary for the construction and use of the pedestrian bridge. Approval of this item shall include any and all necessary agreements in conjunction with the issuance of these easements.

Being a portion of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section 34, Township 20 South, Range 61 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada.
