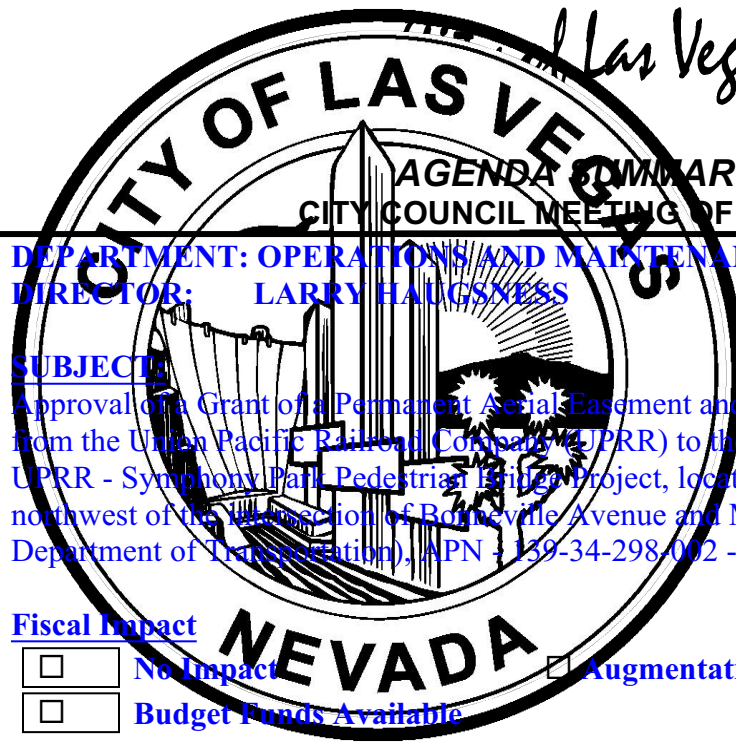

Approval of a Grant of a Permanent Aerial Easement and a Temporary Construction Easement from the Union Pacific Railroad Company (UPRR) to the City of Las Vegas, with regard to the UPRR - Symphony Park Pedestrian Bridge Project, located within the UPRR Right-of-Way, northwest of the intersection of Bonneville Avenue and Main Street (\$50,000.00 Nevada Department of Transportation), APN - 159-34-298-002 - Ward 5 (Barlow)

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

In the furtherance of the UPRR - Symphony Park Pedestrian Bridge Project, it shall be necessary to construct a pedestrian bridge over the Union Pacific Railroad. The bridge will provide pedestrian access from the 500 South Main Street Parking Garage to the Symphony Park development, in particular the Smith Center for Performing Arts. The Permanent Aerial Easement will span the width of the UPRR Right-of-Way in this area, yet there shall be no permanent structure erected in the UPRR Right-of-Way. The Temporary Construction Easement is necessary for the facilitation of construction of the aerial bridge structure. Approval of this item shall include any and all necessary agreements for the issuance of these easements.

Being a portion of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section 34, Township 20 South, Range 61 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada.
