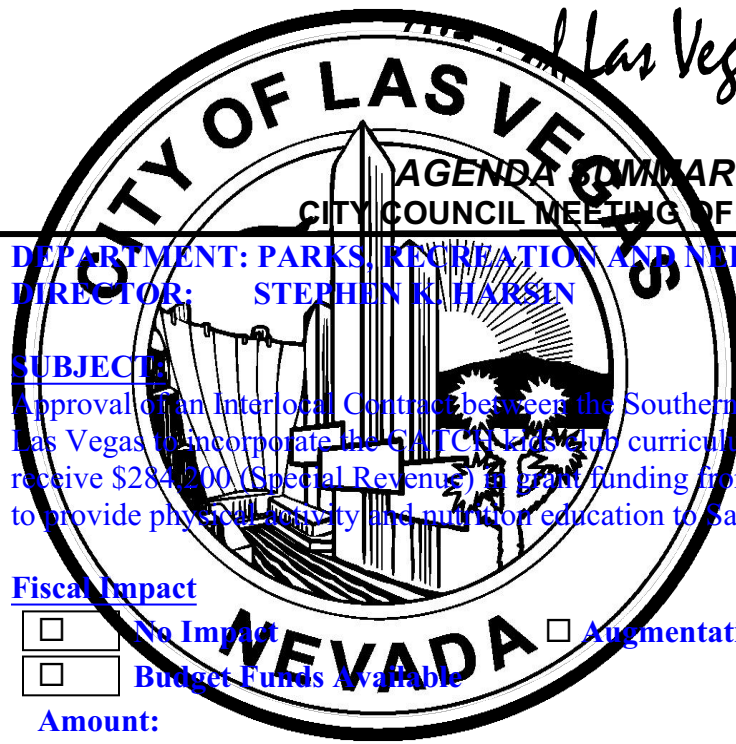

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The CATCH kids club curriculum was developed by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. This program emphasizes the importance of physical activity and nutrition education for grade school children. The Southern Nevada Health Care District (SNHD) entered into a Cooperative Contract with the CDC to expand the use of the curriculum and activities throughout Clark County. It is anticipated that the funding provided through this contract with SNHD will allow the Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services Department to implement the CATCH curriculum and activities throughout the Safekey sites within the City of Las Vegas.
