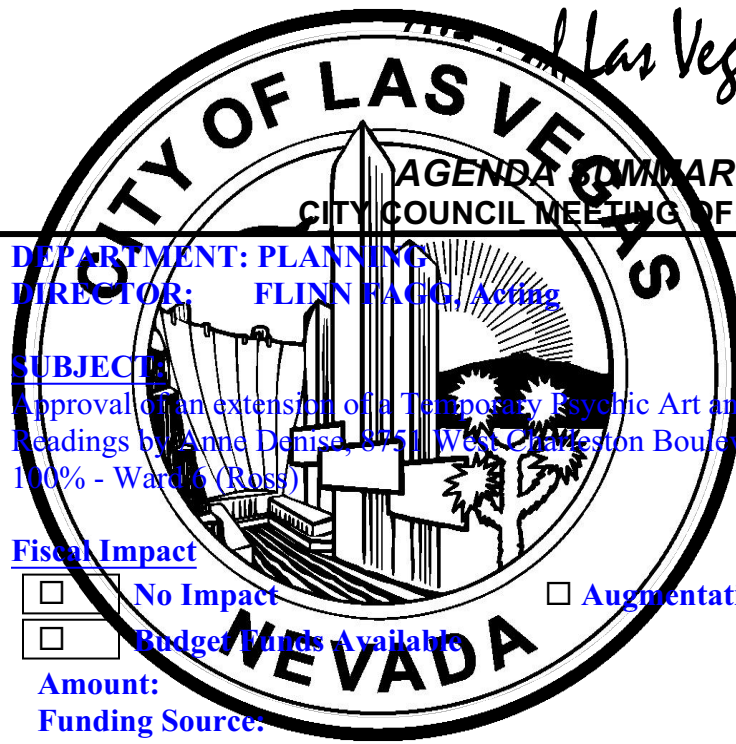

Approval of an extension of a Temporary Psychic Art and Science License.

RECOMMENDATION:

Recommend approval of an extension of the temporary license with the authority of the director or designee to issue a permanent license upon receipt of a favorable investigative report and subject to the following conditions:

1. Rates must be posted in a conspicuous place, visible to patrons, on a sign of at least 8 x 10 in size, with lettering no smaller than one inch.
2. If the licensee operates by donation or indirect method of payment, including remuneration that is at the discretion of the customer, the signage shall indicate such to the patron.
3. The rates published shall be the only rates charged.
