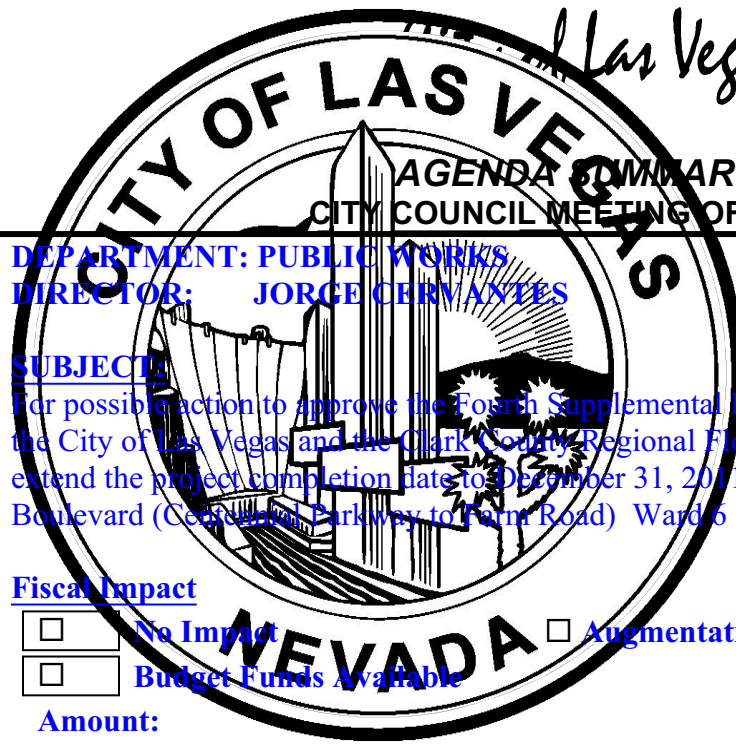

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On August 10, 2006 the CCRFCDD entered into an Interlocal Contract with the City for design associated with the Las Vegas Wash Decatur Boulevard (Centennial Parkway to Farm Road) project. The First Supplemental Interlocal Contract dated April 12, 2007 was approved to increase funding and extend the date of completion. The Second Supplemental Interlocal Contract dated July 12, 2007 was approved to change the scope of the project and to increase funding for the additional design costs. The Third Supplemental Interlocal Contract dated March 12, 2009 was approved to extend the project completion date. This Fourth Supplemental Interlocal Contract will extend the project completion date to December 31, 2011 to allow for project closeout. The CCRFCDD approved this contract at their May 19, 2011 Board Meeting.
