PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On June 6, 2011, the City of Las Vegas received the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) announcement of funding availability under the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program for Fiscal Year 2011. The City of Las Vegas (CLV) has been designated as the fiscal agent of the eligible \$1,273,801 in grant funding.

Minutes:

DEPUTY CITY MANAGER ORLANDO SANCHEZ clarified that this Item is being presented as a qualification for federal assistance and continued to discuss the specific requirements and timelines associated with the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program. The following are the recommended awards: Clark County Justice Court \$103,333, Project REAL - Your Day in Court \$18,533, Project REAL - Play by the Rules \$22,900, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department \$245,337 for the replacement of tasers, Boys and Girls Club of

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Las Vegas \$50,000, Southern Nevada Police Athletic League \$45,000, City of Las Vegas Municipal Court \$267,763, Boys and Girls Club of Southern Nevada \$50,000, Nevada Child Seekers Case Management \$48,529, Nevada Child Seekers Addiction \$43,100, Clark County District Attorney \$229,363, and an administrative fee of \$99,943 to the City of Las Vegas for administering the program for a total of \$1,273,801.

Subsequent to the meeting it was determined that the total amount read for the record included a recommendation of \$50,000 for Clark County Parks and Recreation, which was not one of the recipients read for the record.
