As a "disparate jurisdiction" (largest population distribution in the state and highest in the crime statistics,) the grant is a regional application process that must have agreement between the City of Las Vegas, the City of Mesquite and Clark County.

Funds from the FY 2011 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program (42 U.S.C. 3751 (a)) is the primary provider for federal criminal justice funding to state and local jurisdictions. JAG funds support all components of the criminal justice system, from multijurisdictional drug and gang task forces to crime prevention and domestic violence programs, courts, corrections, treatment and justice information sharing initiatives. JAG-funded projects may address crime through the provisions of services directly to individuals and/or communities and by improving the effectiveness and efficiency of criminal justice systems, processes and procedures.
