PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Interlocal Agreement for Fiscal Year 2012 provides for implementation of SCOPE II to replace the original SCOPE application and the Wanted Vehicle System (WVS). The SCOPE II application is a criminal history repository and a vehicle history system that will be shared among the law enforcement agencies in the Las Vegas Valley. Clark County will direct the implementation on behalf of all of the local agencies. As indicated in the FY12 Interlocal Agreement, the City of Las Vegas will pay, as it did last year, a 6% share (\$45,458) of the total cost of \$763,088. However, it is anticipated that there may be additional (possibly substantial) costs for which the City will be responsible in future years.
