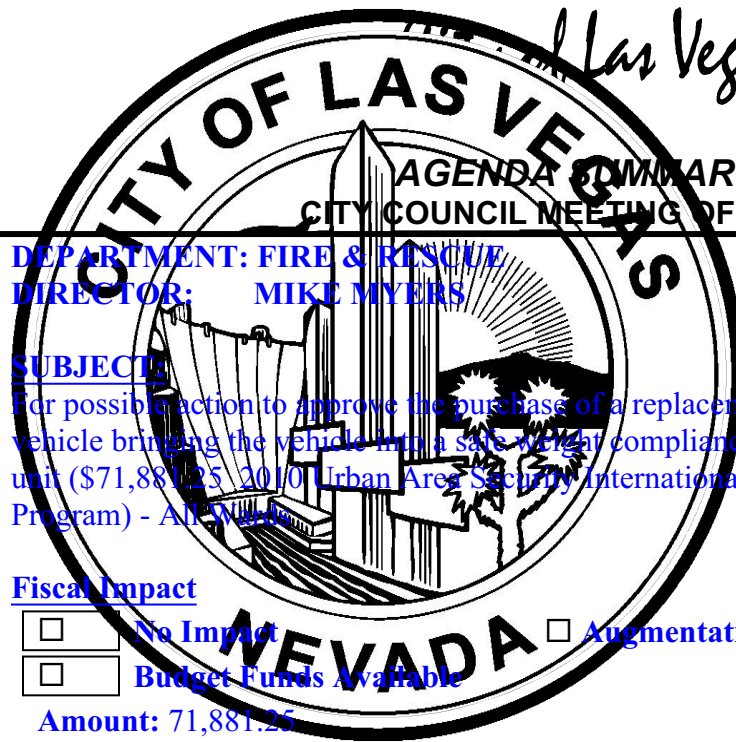

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This purchase is an approved purchase through the 2010 UASI Homeland Security Grant Program. This will increase the current response vehicle weight carrying ability and bring the vehicle into a safe weight operating rating. The chassis of the unit will be replaced but the current box will be re-used. This will save approx \$230,000 in costs, will extend the life of this response vehicle and allow the Bomb Squad team to increase the amount of critical equipment that is carried to an emergency scene.
