PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The City's current practice of handling the disposition of surplus property is limited to on-line auction, in accordance with public purchasing statutes. NRS 268.028 authorizes the City Council or its authorized representative to donate surplus personal property of the city to nonprofit organizations to be used for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the city. This Resolution adds an additional alternative for the disposition of surplus city property.
