PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On July 18, 2011 the Commission for the Las Vegas Centennial Board approved a funding allocation to the Neon Museum in the amount of \$300,000 to be used for the creation of the electronic exhibit hardware and software, historians research, writing and editing of the educational information for exhibit development including script writing and recording for a self-guided tour with narration. Funds will also be used to subsidize a Development Director and staff start up costs, Education/Programming Director, Marketing Director, the audio/visual equipment and a closed captioning television system to be hardwired into the La Concha Visitors Center, and a security system both in the building and the Boneyard.
