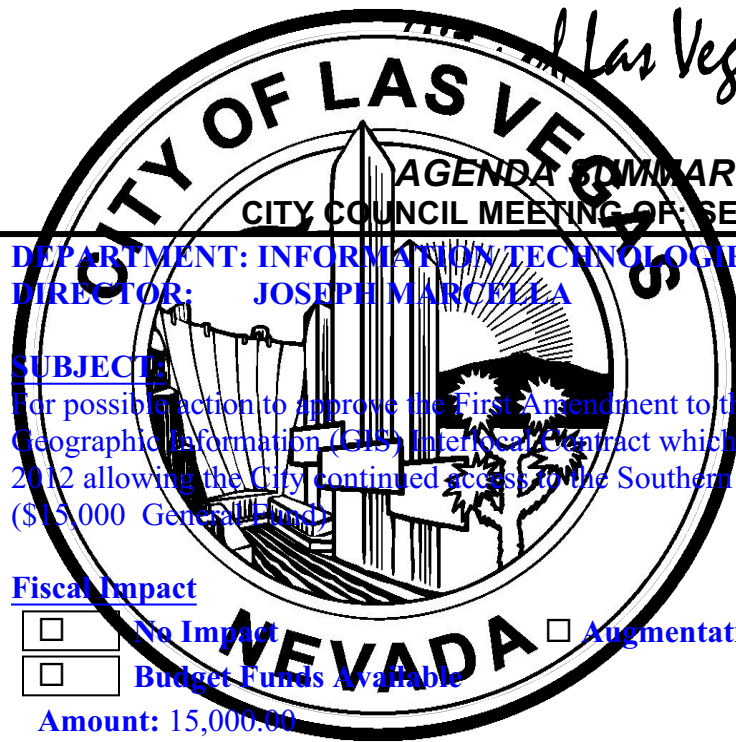

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Geographic Information System (GIS) was established at the City of Las Vegas in the Planning Department in 1988. It was designed from the start to be a part of an enterprise GIS, and the City of Las Vegas became one of the signatory jurisdictions to the Southern Nevada Interlocal GIS, which is overseen by the Clark County GIS Management Office (GISMO). This group consists of state/local/federal government and agencies, utilities and private sector stakeholders who operate, manage or otherwise use GIS in southern Nevada. The effective distribution of authoritative GIS information, the availability of Aerial Photography and the continued staff coordination among all the GIS Interlocal Contract participants, are the keys to our collective ability to deliver timely and efficient services to the public. The GIS Interlocal Contract will continue to provide the City of Las Vegas with data contained in the Southern Nevada GIS Central Repository. Except for party names and fee amounts, all the interlocal contracts have been approved by their respective governing bodies.
