Minutes:

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN recognized October 9-14, 2011, as National Fire Prevention Week. She personally thanked the firefighters for their help and support in keeping the city safe before introducing SPARKY THE FIRE DOG who is celebrating his 60th birthday and presented him with a proclamation.

FIRE AND RESCUE CHIEF MIKE MYERS announced the theme of this year's National Fire Prevention Week is 'Keeping Families Safe from Fire'. He also discussed several fire safety tips that families should observe to promote safety and announced that there will be several events throughout the week for the public to attend. The Chief also recognized all the firefighters who work to keep the City safe and asked DOCTOR DAVID SLATTERY to the podium where (with the aid of the Mayor and Councilmembers) he presented a brief demonstration on cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and the proper use of automated external defibrillators (AEDs). DOCTOR SLATTERY also recognized the emergency services workers who helped with the presentation.
